Intervention and Testing Information

- Students **must attend** 10 hours of intervention for each OGT test that they wish to take.
- Enrollment in each intervention session is limited to 20 students.
- Priority will be given to students enrolled in the JVS with upper classmen receiving first chance.
- The cost for the intervention is \$75.00.
Payment must be received before the first day of the session.
- Deadline for enrollment is June 9, 2011. Students will be notified by email or phone if they have been accepted by June 10, 2011.
- Return enrollment form and payment to the LCJVS Financial Clerk.

Summer Intervention Procedures

Emergency Medical Form:

- Must be on file in the JVS office. Forms are available on the JVS website: www.lcjvs.com

Behavioral Expectations:

- Students will be expected to be on their best behavior. Rule violations or disruption of school may result in students being removed from intervention and testing.
- Students will be held responsible for the rules listed in the LCJVS Student Handbook which is posted on the JVS website.
- Students may not possess or administer medications to themselves while on school grounds. School officials cannot administer medicine to students.

Students Driving to School:

- Students must park in designated parking places in the East parking lot.
- Students will not be permitted to go to their cars or leave campus once class has started.

Students Not Driving to School:

- Students who do not drive may meet their rides in the east parking lot of the JVS when sessions end.
- All persons furnishing rides for students are asked to remain in their cars and not enter the building unless they have made a prior arrangement with the Principal.
