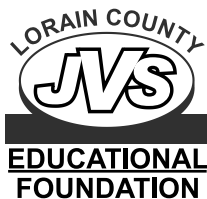

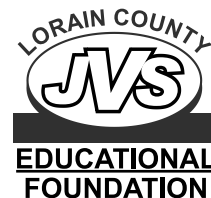

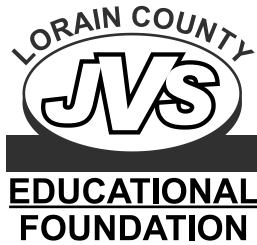

### **William R. Burton Scholarship**

- Established in 1994 by the Lorain County JVS Teachers' Association in memory of William R. Burton, the first Superintendent of the Lorain County JVS. Mr. Burton successfully established the Vocational Center in Lorain County. He established and maintained high standards of performance for the JVS faculty and students. He served as superintendent for 19 years and completed 33 years in education as a teacher and administrator.
- The scholarship is intended for the vocational

student who possesses the drive, skills, and will necessary to succeed in further education or training. It is intended for the student who has a vocational "heart" and "soul".



### **Robert D. Beecheler Memorial Scholarship**

- Established in 2004 in memory of Robert D. Beecheler by his brother William Beecheler, and other family members and friends
- Served in the Navy during World War II; Business owner: Bob's Appliances, Lorain Gas Station; Retired Teacher: Lorain Admiral King, Adult Education; Community Volunteer
- Scholarship will be awarded to an Adult Career Center student enrolled in the Building Trades program who is a veteran or the child of a veteran
- May be used for tuition, textbooks, and/or tools
- Selection is based on the listed criteria and financial need.
- Selection will be conducted by the Adult Career Center Staff in cooperation with the Veteran's Administration.
- The Robert D. Beecheler Memorial Scholarship will be awarded every fall.

# SCHOLARSHIPS

### **J. Edgar Martin Scholarship**

- Established in 2004 in memory of J. Edgar Martin, a benefactor of the Lorain County JVS who bequeathed funds to the JVS to be used for student scholarships.

### **Lorain County JVS Student Memorial Scholarship**

- Established in 2005 in memory of former JVS students who have passed away
- Individuals will be listed in this scholarship if a donation (s) of at least \$500 has been given in memory of the student

#### **SELECTION PROCESS FOR BURTON, MARTIN, HOGAN AND STUDENT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS**

1. May be used for college, technical school, or continuing education courses
2. Selection is based on: application, transcript, letters of recommendation, letter of acceptance and interview
3. Selection is conducted by members of the Lorain County JVS Teachers' Association

#### **Applications are available in student services.**

All scholarships are one-year nonrenewable.

All scholarships will be awarded at the Senior Recognition ceremony.

### **Strive Scholarship**

- Established in 1995 in cooperation with the Elyria Rotary
- Awarded to students who were in the lower 1/3 of their class
- May be used for college, technical school, or continuing education courses
- Selection is based on improvement in attendance and grade point average while at the JVS
- Selection is conducted by Rotary members and JVS staff.

### **Julie L. Hogan Memorial Scholarship**

- Established by in 2005 by family and friends of Julie Hogan
- Student in Marketing and Management 1990-1991, 1991-1992
- State and National DECA (An Association of Marketing Students) competition winner in both her junior and senior years
- Completed Marketing and Management program in 1992
- Attended Kent State University to study education, was awarded a Bachelor of Science in Education, posthumously, in 2004
- Preference will be given to qualified JVS seniors from Brookside High School
- Preference will be based on need and work ethic, not solely on grade point average
