



## Building Trades Academy CARPENTRY

Learn a variety of basic carpentry skills while working on residential or light commercial construction projects.

#### **HEATING and AIR CONDITIONING**

Install, service, and repair residential and commercial heating and air conditioning systems.

#### **INDUSTRIAL ELECTRICITY**

Install, maintain, and troubleshoot a variety of electrical systems with an emphasis on green technology.

#### **MASONRY TRADES**

Create and install durable brick, stone, and concrete surfaces and structures using a variety of sustainable materials and processes.

## Business and Marketing Academy

#### **CYBERSECURITY and NETWORKING**

Learn about cyber threats and how to secure networks and devices from harmful intrusions. Build, upgrade, and repair computers and maintain laptops and mobile devices.

#### **DIGITAL MEDIA ARTS**

Work in a digitally integrated computer lab and studio environment and gain hands-on experience with DSLR cameras as well as digital audio and lighting equipment.

#### **WEB and GRAPHIC DESIGN**

Design, develop, and produce interactive media projects, websites, and social media contexts. Learn photo editing techniques to create, revise, and export for video, print and web.

#### **MARKETING and ENTREPRENEURSHIP**

Obtain knowledge and skills in business activities to develop and implement marketing strategies and techniques. Apply tools, strategies, and processes to communicate digitally with targeted customers and learn the initial steps to establish a business.

## **Community Service Academy**

### **ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES**

Train in patient care techniques and learn anatomy, physiology, medical terminology, and lab procedures. Observe clinical professionals in a variety of health care facilities to explore potential careers.

#### **COSMETOLOGY**

Receive hands-on training in hair, skin, and nail care. Develop skills in the classroom and perform services for clients in the on-site Reflections Salon. Prepare to take the Ohio State Board of Cosmetology exam.

#### **EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION**

Teach 3 to 5-year-old children in the JVS Ohio Department of Education licensed preschool and learn how to plan and conduct developmentally appropriate lesson plans.

#### **LANDSCAPE and GREENHOUSE MANAGEMENT**

Learn landscape, floral design, greenhouse management, and plant propagation. Use landscape equipment such as zero turn mowers and skid loaders. Manage new technologies in plant growth with aeroponic and aquaponic systems.

#### **PUBLIC SAFETY**

Learn first aid and CPR, patient care, ambulance transport, injury assesssment, fire science and protection, pre-hospital care. Prepare to take the Ohio Firefighters II certification test and the National Registry Exam for EMT/B certification.

## SPORTS, HEALTH and FITNESS TECHNOLOGY

Pursue a career in the fitness, sports medicine, and therapy industries. Learn anatomy, exercise physiology, strength conditioning, nutrition, medical terminology, sports medicine, and therapy techniques.

#### **CAREER READINESS | 9TH GRADE**

Placed in a structured lab setting, develop skills and knowledge necessary for acceptance into our career tech programs as a junior. Through the use of different types of equipment, projects, and career modules, learn approporiate safety procedures and obtain a variety of skills that will help you focus on a successful career choice.

### **CAREER EXPLORATION | 10TH GRADE**

Experience different career-technical labs during your sophomore year to help develop skills and gain knowledge necessary for acceptance into our career tech programs as a junior. After completion of this program, you may focus on a career choice that and apply to a two-year JVS career-technical program.

## **Culinary Academy**

#### **BAKERY and PASTRY ARTS**

Learn baking and food preparation techniques, then develop more advanced skills in cake decorating, chocolate sculpture, and plated desserts. Study the science of baking and work in the JVS on-site bakery.

#### **CULINARY ARTS**

Develop advanced cooking techniques while using state-of-the-art equipment to prepare delicious food. Operate the full-service Buckeye Room Restaurant, the JVS on-site restaurant.

## Manufacturing and Pre-Engineering Academy

#### **ENGINEERING DESIGN and TECHNOLOGY**

Collaborate with local businesses to prepare technical and architectural drawings needed to manufacture a variety of parts and structures. Build hands-on models and prototypes of designs. Train in coding and flight of small unmanned aircraft system drones.

#### PRECISION MACHINE TECHNOLOGY

Machine precision metal parts using lathes, mills and CNC equipment. Learn to read blueprints and perform machine maintenance.

#### **WELDING and FABRICATION**

Learn manual, TIG, MIG, and arc welding along with automated welding techniques while working on real world projects.

## **Transportation Academy**

#### **AUTO TECHNOLOGY**

Diagnose and repair today's modern cars. Learn about brakes, electrical systems, steering and suspension, and engine performance.

#### **COLLISION REPAIR**

Work on vehicles that require frame and body straightening, welding, refinishing, and painting.

#### **COMMERCIAL TRUCK TECHNOLOGY**

Maintain and repair diesel powered trucks with a focus on electronic engine control. Learn about air brakes, drive trains, electrical systems, steering, and suspension.

#### **INDUSTRIAL EQUIPMENT MECHANICS**

Maintain and repair small engines, power sports vehicles, agricultural, and construction equipment. Focus on gasoline and diesel engines, electrical systems, hydraulics, and drive trains.

## CAREER BASED INTERVENTION 12TH GRADE

Designed for senior students who are academically on track for graduation and are looking for real world work experience during the lab portion of their school day.

#### **HOSPITALITY SERVICES A/B**

Learn basic skills used in the hotel and restaurant industry.
Learn basic food preparation and housekeeping competencies used in industry. Operate commercial washing machines and dryers, and learn to safely operate restaurant and institutional equipment. Focus on developing employability skills necessary to advance in the industry.

#### **JOB TRAINING PROGRAM**

Learn basic work skills such as following written or sample directions, staying on task, working with good speed and quality in order to meet deadlines.

#### **MAINTENANCE SERVICES A/B**

Explore basic carpentry, electrical, flooring, HVAC, painting, plumbing, and roofing. Learn proper installation for drywall, windows and doors. Learn the proper use of hand tools and power equipment related to the residential construction industry.
