- 4. New members will be announced at a Tapping Ceremony on Friday, April 5, 2024.

A JVS student demonstrates service by taking an active role in the program's Career-Technical Student Organization (BPA, DECA, Skills USA, FFA, FCCLA, HOSA), participating in other JVS organizations such as VYC, being employed, participating in service projects, participating in associate school activities and by taking an active role in the community and/or church.				
RECOMMENDATION:	Teacher Recommendation Sheets must have a score of at least 80%. A minimum of two outside academic recommendations for Tech Prep/half day students.				
DEADLINES:	Candidates must meet all deadlines for submitting required forms.
