The scholarship amounts vary depending on available dollars, the number of students being awarded, their financial need, and other individual variables as determined by the Malone family.

The Malone family is looking for students with passion, drive, energy, a sense of humor and financial need. There is no tangible list of requirements. The Malone family firmly believes in tolerance and acceptance and therefore these characteristics are a requirement of all Malone Scholars. If you receive the Malone Scholarship you will be joining the Malone scholarship family, and it is a diverse family. Students of all races, religions, ethnic backgrounds and sexual preferences are welcome in the Malone Scholarship family.

To be eligible for consideration, applicants must be attending a College Now served high school in Cuyahoga, Medina, Lorain or Summit counties. Applicants must qualify for the Federal Pell Grant. Strong preference will be given to students attending a college or university in the state of Ohio.

Those applying for the Malone Scholarship should be meeting with a College Now advisor and submit the following required materials:

- ❑ Complete College Now Scholarship Application
- ❑ Be recommended by your College Now advisor
- ❑ Have a cumulative weighted GPA of at least a 2.5
- ❑ Official High School Transcript
- ❑ Have a minimum ACT composite score of 18 **OR** combined verbal and math SAT score of 860 prior to 3/1/2016 or 940 after 3/1/2016
- ❑ Documentation of ACT or SAT scores
- ❑ 2017/2018 Student Aid Report (SAR) or FAFSA confirmation page
- ❑ College Award Letter (if available)
- ❑ Student essay, typed, 1 page, why student needs a scholarship, include any special circumstances, obstacles, what he/she wants to major in, career goals, dreams, aspirations, etc.
